Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Marci Andino:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act.

Under the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act, §30-4-10 et seq., We are requesting an opportunity to inspect or obtain copies of public records of any conversations (electronic, verbal, and/or written), as it pertains to the decision to appeal the absentee witness requirement during the 2020 Election Cycle; any decisions regarding absentee ballots during the 2020 Election Cycle; and any and all votes in during the Georgia State 2020 Election Cycle between the following:

1. The South Carolina Election Commission Office and ANY South Carolina County Election Commission Office, its officers, staff employees, contract employees, Board members, and/or volunteers AND
2. The Offices of Governor Henry McMaster and Senator Lindsay Graham, its officers, staff employees, contract employees, Board members and/or volunteers.
3. Any communications between the SCEC, officers, board members, SCEC staff and Senator Lindsey Graham and/or his staff.

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform us of the cost. However, we would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of whether there were any instances of voter fraud and/or suppression committed during the 2020 Election Cycle. The integrity of elections in the State of South Carolina is of high importance to South Carolina voters and the South Carolina Democratic Party. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes.

The South Carolina Freedom of Information Act requires a response time within 15 business days. If access to the records I am requesting will take longer than this amount of time, please contact us with information about when I might expect copies or the ability to inspect the requested records.

If you deny any or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law.
