HOW TO VOTE

Register to Vote by Email:

If you wish to cast your votes via email ballot **you must register by 10 PM on Monday, May 17** and provide the email address you prefer to use to receive your ballots. **To register, go to www.scdp.org and click on the 2021 State Convention button on the top menu bar**. Your first ballot will be sent at 3:30 p.m. on May 19. If you have registered and you don't receive a ballot in your email, please call 803-799-7798.

If you do not have an email address and wish to vote by telephone, you do not need to register by May 17 at 10 p.m.

The **Platform and Resolutions Committee** and the **Rules and Credentials Committee** will hold an information and comment Zoom session on Tuesday, **May 18 at 6 p.m**. for delegates and alternates who wish to learn more or comment about the proposed committee reports included in this mailing. Voting by Telephone:

If you wish to vote by phone, please dial **803-799-7798**. If you do not register by 10 PM on Saturday, May 17, you may vote by telephone.

Phones will be answered by SCDP staff members to take your votes on:

Wednesday, May 19 from 3:30 p.m. until 7 p.m. Thursday, May 20 from 3:30 p.m. until 7 p.m. Saturday, May 22 from 10:30 a.m. until 2 p.m.

If you call and the phone is not answered by a live voice, please try again until a live voice answers. Do not leave a message. Your call will not be returned and a message will not constitute a vote.

THE VOTING PROCESS

Beginning at 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 19, until 7 p.m. on Wednesday, May 19, delegates and alternates will vote on *the Rules Committee Report, which includes the Convention Rules and two proposed State Party Rules changes*, via secure online ballots or by phone. **Please pay attention to the Register to Vote and Vote by Phone information above.**

Beginning at 3:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 20, until 7 p.m. on Thursday, May 20, State Convention delegates and alternates will vote on the Platform and Resolutions Committee Report as well as the Convention Officers. Delegates will vote via secure online ballots or by phone.

ALTERNATE VOTES

Alternates to the State Convention may vote. Following each round of voting, if a county has not cast all of its allotted votes, the County Chair will determine which alternates will be moved up to delegate, just as the County Chair would do if we were meeting in an in-person convention. The votes of those alternates will then be counted.
