

## POP-UP VOTER REGISTRATION

There are many ways to help register people to vote! Contact one of the Register 46 Organizers to discuss what works best for you. This will depend on how you operate your group, business, event, or organization.

For example, if you run a food truck, you can provide voter registration information and materials at your stops. Some of our partners have incentivized voter registration by offering a small, expendable "freebie" for the "first 25 people to register to vote". Of course, no one is required to do this, but it's an option that some partners have used to help promote both their business and voter registration.

Register 46 can provide partners with a QR code that, once scanned, will open VoteBlueSC.com. Once people open VoteBlueSC.com, they can check their registration status, get information about how to obtain an ID if they don't have one, correct outdated ID information on the spot, and register to vote in approximately five minutes.

This QR code is the best method we have to register voters. It keeps all private information in the hands of the person registering to vote and allows them to register to vote almost instantly. This QR code can be hung up at the location, placed in a display, or made available on a clipboard.

Register 46 can provide backup paper voter registration forms to keep on hand for people who do NOT have a state ID or the ability to use the QR code. Applicants will only be required to enter the last four digits of their social security number to complete a paper application. If paper forms are used, they should be collected, kept safe, and turned over to a Register 46 organizer, designated person/volunteer, or dropped off at the local Democratic Party for "Register 46".
